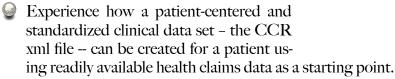
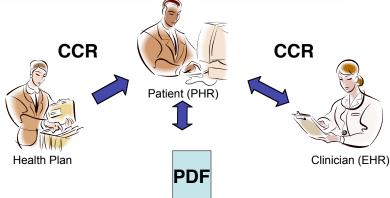
Continuity of Care Record Portability Demonstration

The TEPR CCR Demo uses the ASTM Continuity of Care Record (CCR), an open XML standard, as the vehicle for transporting a core set of clinically relevant personal health data between different software applications, such as a personal health record (PHR) used by a patient and an electronic health record (EHR) used in a physicians' office or a hospital.





Standard Forms

- Experience the exchange (transport, view, import) of the health information among different software applications, including PHRs and EHRs, from different vendors.
- See the opportunities available once a CCR is created such as pre-populating standard forms
- Various options for transport are demonstrated, including USB drive, cell phone, and web-based patient registry. The latter utilizes a new open Internet protocol the Commons eX-change Protocol (CXP) to facilitate secure point-to-point transfer or CCR files over the Internet.
