
Doctors should always make medical decisions based on your complete and accurate medical data

Frequently, doctors will make decisions that impact your health, based on partial, or at worse, incorrect information.

Paper-based systems, human error, incorrect memory of health events, or other circumstances may jeopardize the correctness of the data that your doctor uses.

- Prepare for doctor visits, and keep track of the medical advice


The health information you need; the way you need it
